

MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Membership eligibility at the FirstLight Federal Credit Union /shall be limited to those having the following common bond:

- Military and civilian personnel of the United States Government who work at or are assigned or attached to Fort Bliss, Texas, Biggs Army Airfield or William Beaumont General Hospital at Fort Bliss, Texas;
- Active duty and reserve personnel assigned to 900th Quartermaster Petroleum Company (supply)(Type B), El Paso, Texas;
- Active duty and reserve personnel assigned to Headquarters Company 383RD Petroleum Battalion (operating), El Paso, Texas;
- Active duty and reserve personnel assigned to the 263^{re} S&S Company, El Paso, Texas;
- Active duty and reserve personnel assigned to the 5035th Garrison Unit, El Paso, Texas;
- Active duty and reserve personnel assigned to Naval and Marine Corps Reserve Center, El Paso, Texas;
- Members of the 203rd Security Police Flight Air National Guard Units, El Paso, Texas;
- Military personnel of foreign governments while assigned to Fort Bliss, Texas;
- Members of this credit union who are stationed at military bases overseas and retain their membership in this credit union;
- Staff and faculty of the Boards of Education who work in the public schools of Dona Ana and Sierra Counties, New Mexico;
- Staff and faculty of New Mexico State University who are paid or supervised from Las Cruces, New Mexico;
- Members of the Las Cruces Retired Teachers Association who qualify for membership in accordance with its constitution and bylaws as of the date of its addition to this field of membership;
- Persons retired as pensioners or annuitants from the above employment
- Retired members of the armed forces of the U. S. Government who utilize the facilities of Fort Bliss or the William Beaumont General Hospital
- Widows or widowers of deceased members of the U.S. Government Armed Forces (active or retired) who utilize the facilities of Fort Bliss or William Beaumont General Hospital
- Employees of this credit union and members of their immediate families, which include parents, grandparents, brother, sister, children, grandchildren and their spouses.
- Persons who live, work or worship in, and businesses and other legal entities located in the low-income community of Dona Ana County, New Mexico;

- Persons who live, work or worship in, or attend school in, and businesses and other legal entities located in the underserved area of El Paso, County, Texas;(11/16/01)
- Members of their immediate families, which include parents, grandparents, brother, sister, children, grandchildren and their spouses.
- Registered students at New Mexico State University and the Dona Ana Branch Community College who are enrolled at the main campus at University Park, New Mexico;
- Registered students in the Las Cruces School District No. 2 public schools and Gadsden Independent School District; and organizations of such persons;
- Volunteers of the above named entities;
- Spouses of persons who died while within the field of membership of this credit union; and organizations of such persons;

There is no minimum age requirement to open a savings account. Persons under the age of 18 must have an adult joint member. (Preferably a parent or guardian)
